



ECOSPILL LEVEL 3 SPILL TRAINING TRAIN THE TRAINER

Overview:

This advanced course is designed for up to four competent key personnel or your designated in-company trainers who will be responsible for delivering Level 1 basic spill kit training to colleagues. It combines the full level 1 foundation content with an additional section at the start focused on preparing trainers to confidently run sessions within their own workplace.

The course is not intended to teach general presentation skills or how to become a professional trainer. Instead, it is aimed at experienced trainers or suitably skilled personnel who are already confident leading workplace training sessions.

Duration & Delegate Info

Session length: Up to 3 hours

Max attendees per session: 4 delegates

Course Objectives:

By the end of this course, attendees will:

- Understand what constitutes a spill and the types of hazards involved.
 - Be able to identify, select, and safely use absorbents and spill kits.
 - Recognise the importance of having a simple, effective spill response plan.
 - Appreciate the environmental, financial, and reputational impact of unmanaged spills.
 - Be equipped to take practical first-response action using the spill control products available on-site.
 - Learn in application with an internal and external demonstration.
 - To be able to present a Level 1 course back to their colleagues.
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Course Outline:

- Train the trainer section – some simple steps to help train colleagues.
 - Defining spills – incidental vs emergency.
 - Common causes and consequences of spills.
 - Understanding governing legislation.
 - Statistics and real-world examples.
 - An explanation of Emergency Spill Response framework and the '10-step plan' for safe and effective spill response.
 - Overview of typical absorbents and their uses.
 - A run through of the Ecospill product ranges.
 - An internal demonstration.
 - A summary and some examples of 'bad practices'.
 - Finish with a Q&A and interactive discussion.
 - Time to study a section of the Level 1 presentation.
 - A presentation back to the group of a section of the Level 1 course.

- A training room with sufficient seating, with space to effectively carry out a dry demonstration for up to 4 attendees.
